

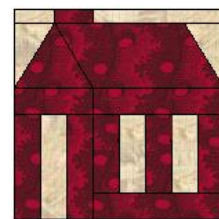

SOS Quilting meets monthly from 9AM to 4PM Drop in anytime, or bring your machine and spend the whole day. Refreshments are usually there, and bring your own lunch if you plan on staying the day.

You can contribute time to making quilts for the kids at SOS, or you can bring your own projects to complete.

The October and November dates (10/11 and 11/16) will be spent making 100 Christmas Stockings for the kids at SOS, plus pillow cases to stuff in the stockings. The pillowcases require 3/4 yards of focus fabric, and 1/4 yards for the cuff of the pillowcase. SOS has asked that there be no religious themes in the fabric.

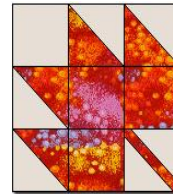


Block Swap Lottery for October meeting - October 14 2014.

The block for **October** is a 12” block from Quilt Blocks Galore. The submitted block or blocks should measure 12.5 inches unfinished. For October I have chosen the Maple Leaf block—in fall colors. You can make 1 or make 3 or make 6—it’s up to you. Each block you submit earns you a ticket which will then be drawn during the October meeting. So if you submit 1 block, you get 1 ticket. If you submit 2 blocks you get 2 tickets! No hard math here—1 block = 1 ticket! The winner walks away with **ALL** of the blocks. If there are more than 12 blocks, then there will be 2 drawings—12 to the first ticket drawn and the remainder to the next ticket, and so on.

Orzo Salad

Recipe courtesy of Giada De Laurentiis

And

Arlene Moloney

4 c. chicken broth

1 ½ c orzo

1 (15 oz.) can garbanzo beans, drained & rinsed

(I substituted peppers & cucumbers for beans)

1 ½ c. red & yellow grape tomatoes, halved

¾ c. chopped red onion

½ c chopped fresh basil

¼ c. chopped fresh mint leaves

About ¾ c Red Wine Vinaigrette, recipe follows

Salt & freshly grd black pepper

Red Wine Vinaigrette: *(Makes enough for 2 salads.)*

½ c. red wine vinegar

¼ c. fresh lemon juice

2 tsp. honey

2 tsp. salt

¾ tsp freshly grd black pepper

1 c. extra-virgin olive oil

Directions.

Pour the broth into a heavy lag saucepan. Cover & bring to boil over high heat.

Stir in the orzo. Cover and cook til tender/firm to the bite, about 7 min.

Drain thru a strainer. Transfer the orzo to a lg. wide bowl & toss til orzo is cool.

Set aside to cool completely.

Toss the orzo w/ veggies, herbs & ½ the dressing to coat. Serve at room temp.

Vinaigrette:

Mix the vinegar, lemon juice, honey, salt & pepper in a blender. With the machine running, gradually blend in the oil. Salt & pepper to taste.

(I put all in a sm. jar and shake.)
