We have chosen the theme of WINGS for the Challenge Project - to be shown at the 2020 Quilt Show. That gives us all a little bit over a year to create something.

All forms of WINGS are welcome - everything from endangered Honey Bees or Monarch Butterflies or Dragon Flies - to the beautiful angels of our imaginations!

If you have not yet given up the fantasy of the winged horses of our childhood fairy tales, now's the time to put them to work. And as long as we are talking about fairy tales - well fairies also have WINGS, right? How about a quilt of flying geese?

Your inspiration might be from a song – Broken Wings by Mr. Mister, or The Wind Beneath My Wings by Bette Midler? The Harley Davidson Wings? Inspiration is everywhere.

You are invited to do an art quilt OR a traditional quilt - it's entirely up to you.

If you have some pretty angel fabric or butterfly fabric you have been saving - now is your chance to use it!

GUIDELINES

- any colors - no limit!
- any size or shape, but no larger than 24 inches, square or in Quilt show terminology – maximum size - no bigger than 96 inches. (24 x 24 x 24 x 24 = 96) or smaller.
- can be something wearable or utilitarian!
- must be quilted and bound.
- if you are moved to make a series of 2 or more pieces, as in showing how you evolved with the Wings theme, each piece would count as an entry. Number them as 1 of ?, 2 of ?, 3 of ? so they can hang together on the wall. There would be no limit to the number of entries you may have.
